## **Students' Instructions for Thesis Presentation**

The undergraduate thesis presentation 1 has been scheduled on November 27, Tuesday, 2018

## Reporting Time: 8:45 AM. (may vary according to board)

## **Guidelines:**

- 1. You must be present at the reporting time, .
- 2. You will have to submit to the officer/lab attendant the following:
  - a. **Three** copies of printout of your presentation. You can print multiple slides (e.g., 2/4) per page and in both side of the page.
  - Three copies (no need to bind it in a book format) of your thesis book/report written so far i.e., introduction, background, literature review and work/research plan (only if your supervisor wants).
- 3. There will be a "Thesis Presentations" folder in the desktop of a designated pc in the presentation lab/class. You will have to create a folder with your student ids and copy your presentation slide, pdf version of the slide, and your thesis report in it. For example if your group consists of: 1405xxx and 1405yyy (in ascending order of roll), your folder name will be: 1405xxx 1405yyy. You must complete this within 8:55 AM.
- 4. You will be presenting your work in front of a thesis board consisting of three faculty members.
- 5. The time allotment for the presentations is as follows:
  - a. 1 person group: 11 minutes (9 minutes of presentation + 2 minutes of Q&A)
  - b. 2 or 3 person group: 15 minutes (12 minutes of presentation + 3 minutes of Q&A)
  - c. 4 or 5 person group: 20 (16 minutes of presentation + 4 minutes of Q&A)
- 6. Presentations must cover following:
  - a. Problem definition and motivation
  - b. Related work
  - c. Work plan/ Tentative Methodology
- 7. All students of a group must present by turns.
- 8. You will decide who presents which part of the presentations. However, the board may ask any student to present any part, or interrupt during presentation and switch the speaker.
